SUBJECT: Removal of Bug Screen

MODELS AFFECTED: J4 Cubs, Serial Nos. 4-710 to 4-823 incl.

As a precautionary measure, the Civil Aeronautics Authority requests that the bug screen, now installed inside the carburetor air scoop, be removed.

The hazard arising from the screen becoming clogged with bugs, thus stopping the flow of air to the carburetor, is in the opinion of the Authority a far greater danger than the presence of bugs in the carburetor. Therefore, after the removal of this screen, a constant check of the carburetor should be maintained.

An appropriate entry must be made in the log book. This entry is necessary for the information of the Authority Inspector.
