Within the next fifty (50) hours PART I time in service.

Within the next fifty (50) hours PART II time in service, and every five hundred (500) hours thereafter.

Every one-thousand (1000) hours of PART III operation thereafter.

PURPOSE Service experience indicates that continual operation on extremely rough terrain or rough water may possibly cause fatigue failure in the wing lift strut forks.

This Service Bulletin provides inspection and fatigue life requirements applicable to the wing lift strut forks. Failure to comply could lead to structural failure due to metal fatigue.

INSTRUCTIONS:

PART I --

1. Install "No Step" Decal, Piper Part Number 80944-02, on each wing lift strut approximately six (6) inches from the bottom of the struts, or paint the statement "NO STEP" in one (1) inch minimum high letters, in a color which contrasts with the airplane color, on each wing lift strut approximately six (6) inches from the bottom of the struts, and in such direction that the "No Step" caution can be read when entering and leaving the airplane.

PART II --

- 1. Remove lift strut forks and inspect for cracks by "magnetic" means.
- 2. Replace cracked lift strut forks before further flight with new lift strut forks listed below under Material Required.
- 3. For Aircraft Model Series PA-12, PA-14, PA-16, PA-18, PA-19, PA-20, PA-22, J-5, J-4, L-14, L-18, L-21, AE-1, and HE-1:
 - a. Inspect lift strut forks to insure that the threads are manufactured with rolled threads.
 - b. To distinguish between machined (cut) and rolled threads, a 10X-power magnifying glass should be used to examine the threads. A rolled thread is processed by a thread die configuration which upsets the material when forming the thread. This results in an even thread surface with generous radius in the root of the thread. A machined (cut) thread will show machining marks and "tear" areas on the thread surface along with sharp V-shaped roots, all caused by the cutting tool. Both conditions are easily discernbile under a magnifying glass and not readily recognized with the naked eye.
 - c. For Models listed on Part II, Item 3, replace lift strut forks that have machined (cut) threads with new lift strut forks manufactured with rolled threads listed below under Material Required.
- 4. Model Series J-2, J-3, L-4, PA-11, PA-15, PA-17, and NE-1 Aircraft are approved to have lift strut forks manufactured with either machined (cut) or rolled threads.

PART III --

1. On all affected aircraft, replace lift strut forks prior to the accumulation of one-thousand (1,000) hours in service with new lift strut forks manufactured with rolled threads, per Material Required listed below.
